The Mission of Chamblee Charter High School is to foster excellence by promoting the intellectual, social, and moral growth and physical health of every student.

OVERVIEW

Chamblee Charter High School (CCHS) is a public school in the DeKalb County School District located in Chamblee, Georgia. Approximately 1,724 students including approximately 350 seniors make up the school's diverse student body. The student population consists of local attendance area students as well as students from throughout the county through the Charter and Magnet Program for High Achievers. CCHS is a Title I school while being economically diverse.

COURSES & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Seven class periods per day each lasting 50 minutes
- Two 18 week semesters
- 24 credits required for graduation
- Georgia Milestone End of Course (EOC) tests in the following courses: Lit/Comp 9, American Lit, Coordinate Algebra, Analytic Geometry, U.S. History, Economics, and Biology
- Variety of magnet/accelerated and Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered.
- Students participate in dual enrollment at 6 different colleges.
- 29 AP courses offered: Language/Composition, Literature/Composition, Biology, Environmental Science, Chemistry, Physics 1, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Human Geography, Psychology, Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, World History, US History, Studio Art : 2D, Studio Art: 3-D, Studio Art: Drawing, Music Theory, Computer Science A, Spanish Language, German Language. AP courses new to CCHS in 2018 include Computer Science Principles, Physics C, French, Government, Seminar, and Art History.

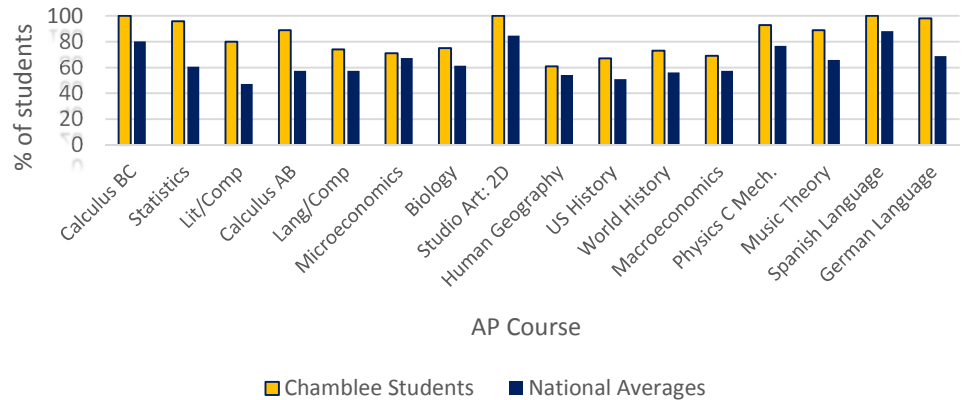

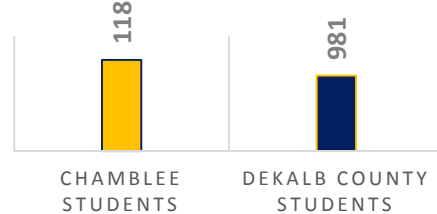


AP TEST SCORES

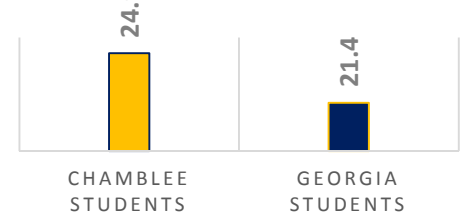
Comparing Percentage of Students Scoring a 3 or Higher on AP Exams in 2018
