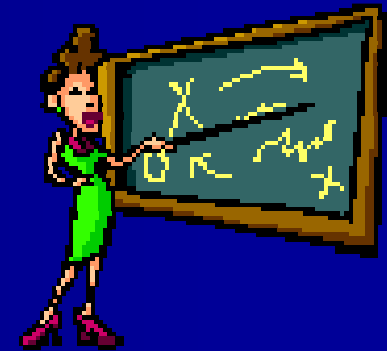


What Are Credits/Units?

- A **UNIT** or **CREDIT** is successful completion of 2 semesters of a course (subject) of study.
- A **CORE UNIT** Includes:
 - ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES, AND WORLD LANGUAGE.

For promotion to the next grade you will need:

- 10TH Grade - 6 UNITS
- 11TH Grade - 12 UNITS
- 12TH Grade - 18 UNITS
- GRADUATE- 24 UNITS

Diploma Seals

- **Honors/Distinction**
 - 3.5 cumulative GPA and 3.0 core GPA
 - 3 years of the same world language
- **College Prep**
 - 2 years of same world language
 - No minimum GPA
- **Career Technology**
 - 1 year of same world language
 - 3 units of career tech electives in same pathway
 - No minimum GPA

New Testing Rules

Students who enter Grade 9 for the first time
in 2011-2012 or after

- Are required to pass courses* associated with GA Milestones, with scores contributing 20% to course grade
- Are not required to pass GA Milestones
