Graduating from high school is a once in a lifetime achievement! In order to graduate, students in DeKalb County Schools must:

- Satisfy attendance requirements
- Successfully complete the required high school coursework (24 units)

COURSEWORK

Students entering high school in the fall of 2009 and after must complete 24 units of coursework in order to graduate. DeKalb County School System ~ Program of Study Requirements for Class of 2012 and subsequent years.

*One unit may be exempt through validated full-year participation in school sponsored athletics, marching band, dance and/or JROTC.

DeKalb County Diploma Seals

There are three different types of diploma seals a student can earn.

Honors/Distinction Diploma Seal requires 3 units of the same world language and a core GPA of 3.0 and an overall cumulative GPA of 3.5.

College Prep Diploma Seal requires 2 units of the same world language with 3 units of electives in the same concentration (Career Technology or Humanities).

Career Technology Seal requires 1 unit of the same world language and 3 units of Career Tech electives.

Georgia Milestones Assessment (End of Course)

Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, a student's EOC score is averaged in as **20%** of the final course grade. The student must have a final course grade of 70 or above to pass the course and earn credit toward graduation.
