American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarship DEADLINE: April 7, 2017

The American Fire Sprinkler Association (AFSA) will award ten \$2,000 scholarships during their annual National Scholarship Contest. To apply students read a short essay about sprinklers and fire safety. After finishing, they complete a 10-question quiz on what they just read. Each correct answer gives the student a chance at winning of ten \$2,000 scholarship (maximum 10 changes per entrant). To be eligible, applicants must be a high school senior and plan to attend a college, university or trade school in the US in the fall. Winners are randomly selected to receive a scholarship payable one-time directly to their respective institution of higher learning. The scholarship is open to US citizens and legal residents.
