Mississippi Excellence in Teaching Program (METP) Scholarship DEADLINE: Dec 1, 2017

Qualified high school applicants must have a 28 or above on their ACT or a score of 1310 or above on the SAT and a 3.5 overall GPA. Participating scholars receive an award covering full tuition, books, room and board, and incidental expenses for four years of attendance along with a one-time technology stipend. To apply for the award, student must first be admitted to Mississippi State University.

USC School of Cinematic Arts DEADLINE: December 1, 2017
